BACKGROUND:

US Synthetic is committed to education, particularly in science, engineering and math for our young people and wants to influence individual lives, families, and our community for the good. It is our goal to provide your high school with a program that will enhance the academic initiatives that are already in place. We strongly believe that through the Keys to Success program, we can help inspire change in students' lives by motivating, recognizing and rewarding them for their improvements in educational performance.

This scholarship in conjunction with the Keys to Success Program in your high school is part of US Synthetic's ongoing commitment to education.

ELIGIBILITY:

- High school seniors who have been awarded a Keys to Success Key Card.

VALUE:

- \$1,000 scholarship to the qualified higher education institution of your choice.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Interested students must submit a completed application, personal statement outlining their interest in science, math or engineering, and letter of recommendation.
- Students must show an interest in pursuing education or careers in science, engineering or manufacturing engineering or math. The student must have maintained a "B" average in an advanced placement (AP) or concurrent enrollment course in math, science, engineering or manufacturing by graduation of high school.
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Applications must be turned into school Keys to Success contact person **two weeks before the Keys to Success Assembly**. Incomplete applications and packets will not be considered.
- **NOTE: ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS MAY BE ADDED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF UTAH. NO ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS WILL BE ADDED AFTER FEBRUARY 6, 2012.**

SCHOLARSHIP TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- Scholarship recipients are required to attend a luncheon in their honor at US Synthetic in Orem, UT and participate in a day-long "LEAN Manufacturing 101 Workshop". The workshop will include a fascinating tour of US Synthetic's world-class LEAN Manufacturing facility where we produce diamond cutters for the oil and gas industry. Their professor or counselor from their school is also invited to attend the workshop. Parents are invited to the luncheon.
- Scholarship recipients must enroll in and attend **at least 6 credit hours at the University of Utah**.
- Funds will be paid directly to the school. Scholarship funds will not be paid directly to students. **No cash will be awarded to students**. Scholarship funds may be applied to tuition & fees.
- Scholarship monies left over from \$1,000 amount will roll over into students' next semester of school.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS:

- Applicants must submit a one page personal statement that states how the Keys to Success program has influenced them in driving their academic performance and which outlines their interest in science, math or engineering as an educational pursuit or a career.
 - Applicants must submit a one page letter of recommendation written by a teacher, counselor or administrator.
 - Letters should contain details on the applicant's background and why they deserve the scholarship.
 - Letters should contain personalized information about the applicant.
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CERTIFICATION & RELEASE:

All applicants, and where appropriate, their parent or guardian must sign the application certifying that all information provided is true and complete to the best of their knowledge and ability. With their signature and submission of the application, applicants also grant Keys to Success the right to use their application information and likeness for the purpose of promoting and publicizing the Keys to Success Program.
